Children's Church for Pre-K - K, and 1st - 5th grade is available during the 11:00 hour. An usher will be glad to help direct you to the appropriate classroom.

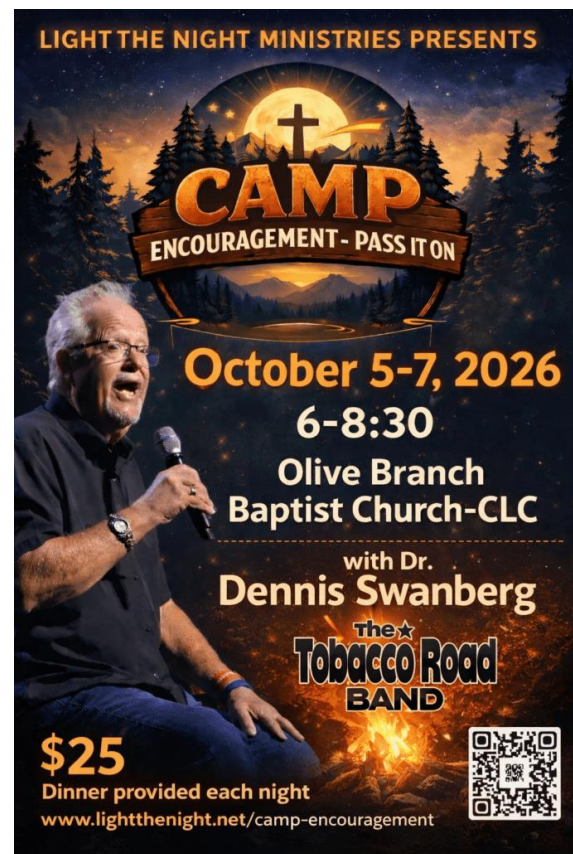
We have a Sensory Room available in the Educational Wing. (1st door on the right past the lady's restroom)
