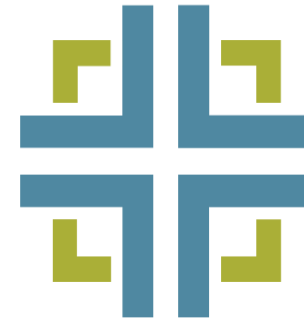

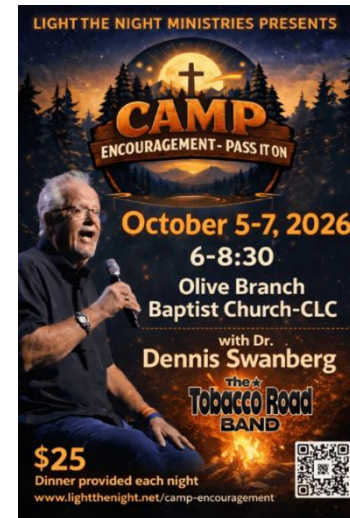
Childcare for babies - toddlers is available for both worship services.
