6. What's the most heroic thing you've ever done that nobody noticed but you?
7. What does “taking territory” for God's kingdom look like in your everyday life — at home, work, school, or in your community?
8. If you had a superhero origin story, what ordinary weakness of yours would somehow become your superpower?
9. If your life had a mission statement based on Mark 16:15 and Isaiah 61:1, what would it say?
10. Have you ever surrendered control of something and then immediately tried to take it back?
