Discussion questions and conversation starters based on this weekend's sermon!

1. What does it mean to you personally that Jesus is an eternal King, not just a historical one?
2. What's your first reaction when someone messes up—grace or judgment?
3. How does knowing that God's grace is still active today change the way you view your own story?
4. What's something you've held onto longer than you probably should have (a grudge, stress, control, etc.)?
5. Is there anything in your past that still tries to define you? How does grace speak into that?
6. Have you ever been surprised by someone showing you grace when you didn't expect it?
7. Why do you think it's sometimes harder to extend grace to others than it is to receive it ourselves?
8. If your past had a "highlight reel," what's one moment you're glad grace covered?
9. Who in your life might feel "too far gone," and how does this message challenge that mindset?
10. What is one step you can take this week to either receive grace more fully or extend it to someone else?
