3. What do you think God is asking you to use right now that you might be overlooking?
4. The oil stopped when the jars ran out. If the miracle in your life stopped, would it be because God ran out — or because you ran out of jars?
5. The oil kept flowing until there were no more jars. What do you think the connection is between how much we prepare and how much God provides?
6. What's the most nerve-wracking “just trust me” moment you've ever had?
7. What's the difference between delayed obedience and disobedience — and does the difference matter?
8. What's something God has clearly been asking you to do that you've been very creatively avoiding?
9. The sermon said obedience responds quickly. What do you think gets in the way of responding quickly when God asks us to do something?
10. “Saying yes will cost, but saying no costs more.” What's a no you said that you're still paying for?
