Discussion questions and conversation starters based on this weekend's sermon!

1. Moses grew up caught between two worlds – Hebrew by birth, Egyptian by upbringing. Have you ever felt like you didn't fully belong anywhere? How did that shape you?
2. What's something in your house that absolutely cannot be done correctly unless you do it yourself?
3. Moses tried to fix a problem by taking matters into his own hands and it backfired. Can you think of a time you did the same thing?
4. Have you ever tried to "help" someone do something and slowly just taken it over entirely?
5. Fear kept Moses from saying yes to God right away. What kind of fear tends to hold you back?
6. Moses told God "please send someone else." Have you ever tried to get out of something you knew you were supposed to do?
7. Moses got so worn out carrying other people's burdens that he asked God to let him die. What does burnout look like for you, and what do you do about it?
8. Moses hid a body in the sand thinking nobody saw. What's something you thought you got away with that you probably didn't?
9. What's the difference between protecting someone and controlling them?
10. What's something you've delegated to someone else and then immediately gone back and redone yourself?
