3. The sermon said evil reveals a standard. What do you think that means, and how does it change the way you think about right and wrong?
4. What's a situation in your life where you were absolutely convinced you knew better than God – and turned out to be completely wrong?
5. Why do you think it's so hard to accept that God's ways are higher than ours, especially when life feels unfair?
6. If you could ask God one question and get a straight answer right now, what would it be?
7. The message said suffering reveals a Savior. Has there ever been a painful season in your life that ultimately pointed you closer to God?
8. If God told you He was doing something you wouldn't believe even if He told you, how long do you think you'd actually wait before trying to figure it out yourself?
9. Have you ever looked back on a hard season and seen what God was actually doing in it?
10. What's something you were absolutely sure was the worst thing that could happen to you that turned out to be a turning point?
