5. What's the difference between showing mercy because you feel like it and showing mercy as a commitment regardless of how you feel?
6. What's something you are way too proud of that you probably shouldn't be?
7. Have you ever seen bitterness or wrong intentions eventually produce exactly that — disappointment and disillusionment?
8. If chesed — covenant loyalty — was a person in your life, what would their name be and what have they had to put up with from you?
9. How does remembering what God has done change the way you respond to what He's asking?
10. Be honest — have you ever walked into a room and immediately known you were the problem?
