Discussion questions and conversation starters based on this weekend's sermon!

1. If your family had a "Honey Do List Hall of Fame," what unfinished project would be inducted first?
2. What's something you started with great enthusiasm but never finished either because you got discouraged or occupied with something else?
3. The main message of Haggai to the people was for them to "Consider their ways." His sermon is just as relevant to us today as it was when he preached it over 2500 years ago. The struggle was the same: Prioritizing God's kingdom over ours. What's one step you can take to begin to prioritize God's house?
4. What's one thing you thought was going to be amazing but ended up being disappointing?
5. Haggai reminded the people that God was still with them. What is a promise of God that has kept you encouraged in a season that you were discouraged?
6. Where do you need to apply one of the cures of discouragement to your own life this week? (Letting go, looking up, or looking ahead)
7. If you could instantly become an expert builder of one thing, what would it be?
8. In Haggai's day, people delayed rebuilding the temple for 16 years!!!! What are some of the things in our day that God is calling us to do but is easy to put off?
9. Try to remember a time you once compared what you were doing to what someone else was doing or had done. What was the impact it had on you when you did?
10. As a family: Share one area that you have been recently discouraged, then be a Haggai and encourage them as God leads you.
