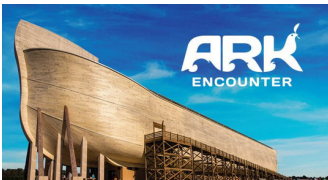


UPWARD FLAG FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING
