

2026-03-11 Discussion Questions

The pastor emphasized that God displays Himself through creation so that people are without excuse. How does observing nature strengthen or challenge your understanding of God's character?

Romans 1:21 states that although people knew God, they neither glorified Him nor gave thanks to Him. How would you honestly assess your own life in terms of glorifying God and expressing gratitude to Him?

The sermon discusses how people can move from knowing God to worshiping created things and eventually themselves. What are some subtle ways this progression might be happening in contemporary culture or even in your own life?

Elihu describes God as wooing us from the jaws of distress. When you experience suffering, do you tend to turn toward God or away from Him, and what might help you respond differently?

The pastor mentioned that we need to know God's principles and absolutes rather than relying on our feelings or experiences alone. What are some core principles about God's character that you would share with someone seeking to know Him?

The sermon warns against becoming desensitized to sin and developing a depraved mind. What spiritual practices or disciplines help you maintain a sensitive conscience before God?

Job's friends tried to interpret his suffering based on their limited understanding of God. How can we support others in their pain without making presumptuous judgments about why they are suffering?

The pastor challenges the idea that it doesn't matter what you believe as long as you believe in God. Why is accurate knowledge of who God is and what He has revealed essential to genuine faith?

Romans 1 describes a progression where God gives people over to their sinful desires when they reject Him. What does this teach us about human freedom, God's patience, and the consequences of persistent rebellion?

The pastor mentioned that we live in a fallen world where some suffering happens simply because Jesus has not yet taken complete control. How does this perspective help you process difficulties that seem to have no clear spiritual explanation?
