How does the contrast between Palm Sunday's praise and Good Friday's condemnation challenge us to examine whether we follow the crowd or stand firm in our convictions about Christ?

What does it mean practically to 'taste and see that the Lord is good' in your daily life, especially during times of worry or uncertainty?

Why do you think the disciples repeatedly asked who would be the greatest despite Jesus teaching them about servanthood multiple times? What does this reveal about human nature?

Jesus said we must become like little children to enter the kingdom of heaven. What specific childlike qualities trust, humility, dependence should characterize our relationship with God?

How does Jesus's warning about causing little ones to sin apply to our responsibility in teaching and protecting children both physically and spiritually in today's world?

What does it mean to 'deny yourself, take up your cross daily, and follow Jesus' in practical terms for your life this week?

The pastor mentioned that many Christians pray about their earthly kingdom rather than God's kingdom. How can we shift our prayers to align more with God's will being done on earth as it is in heaven?

If all our sins and secret actions will be exposed in heaven, how should this reality change the way we live now and how we view others?

What acts of service have you done recently that you didn't want to do but did out of obedience to Christ? How did God meet you in those moments?

Jesus washed the disciples' feet as an example of servant leadership. Who in your life needs you to humble yourself and serve them this week, and

what is holding you back?
