In what areas of your life are you experiencing reluctance to obey what you know God is calling you to do, and what is holding you back from taking action?

How do you distinguish between God's blessings that you should steward well versus material accumulation that might be leading you away from Him?

The sermon mentions that God warns people before bringing judgment. Are there warnings in your own life that you have been ignoring or rationalizing away?

What does contentment look like in practical terms for you, and how does the constant pursuit of more affect your relationship with God?

Are there people in your life who need to hear difficult truths about God's judgment and holiness, and what is preventing you from sharing those truths with them?

How do you balance enjoying the good things God has given you while avoiding the trap of hoarding or believing you deserve them based on your own merit?

The pastor asks if we are justifying the way we live rather than asking God if we are where He wants us to be. What would change in your life if you honestly asked God this question?

Peter warns about scoffers who say everything continues as it always has. How do you guard against spiritual complacency when life seems to be going smoothly?

What are the sins of omission in your life - the things God wants you to start doing that you have been neglecting?

How can you grow in both grace and the knowledge of Jesus Christ simultaneously, avoiding both presumption about salvation and paranoia about losing it?
