How does the story of Cain and Abel reveal the danger of nursing grudges and allowing emotions to control our actions rather than seeking God's guidance?

In what ways do modern conveniences and distractions prevent us from recognizing the spiritual warfare happening in our daily lives?

What does it mean that sin is crouching at your door, and how can we practically master it rather than be mastered by it?

Why do we tend to hide our sins and look around to see who is watching, and what does this reveal about our relationship with authority?

How does submitting to governing authorities, even when we disagree with them, demonstrate our ultimate submission to God's authority?

What is the difference between trying to be good on our own strength versus clothing ourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ and relying on His power?

How does understanding that we cannot make ourselves good lead to true freedom rather than discouragement?

In what ways does the church community help us overcome sin and temptation that we cannot overcome alone?

What does it look like to live as people of the day and light rather than participating in deeds of darkness in our current cultural context?

How can recognizing that all authority has been established by God change the way we pray for and interact with leaders we may not agree with?
