How does the concept of submitting to Christ's authority differ from merely accepting Him as Savior, and what practical implications does this have for daily Christian living?

The sermon discusses how the founding patriots prioritized Christ as their King over earthly rulers. In what ways can modern Christians demonstrate this same priority in their lives today?

Revelation 12 describes war in heaven and Satan being cast down to earth. How does understanding this spiritual warfare context change the way you view the struggles and opposition you face in your faith?

The pastor mentions that Christians overcome by the blood of the Lamb, the word of their testimony, and not loving their lives unto death. Which of these three aspects do you find most challenging to live out, and why?

When the Israelites refused to enter the Promised Land despite God's proven faithfulness, they let fear override trust. What modern-day giants or obstacles cause you to doubt God's ability to lead you forward?

The sermon suggests that much of our struggle with authority stems from wanting to be in charge ourselves. How does this desire for control manifest in your relationship with God, family, or workplace?

Moses reminded the Israelites that God carried them as a father carries his son. How does viewing God's authority through the lens of a loving father rather than a demanding taskmaster change your perspective on submission?

The pastor states that one of the greatest ways to stay on track with Christ is by talking about Him. Why do you think sharing your faith with others strengthens your own spiritual life and resistance to spiritual warfare?

Paul learned to delight in weaknesses and hardships after God told him His

grace was sufficient. What would it look like for you to practically embrace this mindset in a current difficulty you are facing?

The founding generation taught Scripture morning, noon, and night to their children, yet today many Christians rarely read the Bible. What specific changes could you make to prioritize God's Word in your daily life?
