****1 Kings 16:29-30**** — Introduction of Ahab as king of Israel, reigning in Samaria

****1 Kings 16:30-33**** — Ahab doing more evil in the eyes of the Lord than all kings before him, worshiping Baal and setting up an Asherah pole

****1 Kings 17:7**** — The brook drying up because there had been no rain in the land

****1 Kings 17:8-9**** — God commanding Elijah to go at once to Zarephath of Sidon, where a widow had been commanded to supply him with food
