****Mark 6:6-13**** — Jesus sends out the twelve disciples two by two with authority over evil spirits, instructing them to take nothing for the journey

****Luke 5**** — The miraculous catch of fish; Peter, James, John, and Andrew are called to follow Jesus and become fishers of men

****Matthew 9:35-38**** — Jesus travels through towns teaching and healing, feels deep compassion for the harassed and helpless crowds, and declares the harvest is plentiful but workers are few

****Matthew 10**** — The commissioning of the twelve apostles (referenced as the parallel passage to Mark 6)

****2 Corinthians 9:6-12**** — Whoever sows sparingly reaps sparingly; whoever sows generously reaps generously; God loves a cheerful giver and makes all grace abound

****Galatians 6:6-10**** — A man reaps what he sows; sowing to please the Spirit yields eternal life; do not grow weary in doing good
