

This powerful message invites us to examine what it truly means to be children of God, not just by creation but by adoption through faith in Christ. Drawing from John 1, Romans 8, and Galatians 3, we discover that becoming God's children requires more than acknowledging His existence—it demands receiving and believing in Jesus Christ. The transformative truth here is that we're called to live by the Spirit, not by our sinful nature or mere rule-following. When the Spirit of God dwells within us, we're no longer slaves to fear but can cry out 'Abba, Father' with the confidence of beloved children. The sermon challenges us to move beyond religious duty into genuine relationship, where we're led by the Spirit to reflect our Heavenly Father's character. This isn't about perfect performance but about allowing God's Spirit to work within us, producing the fruit of grace and truth that characterized Jesus. The question we must honestly ask ourselves is: Do we have God's Spirit living in us, or are we simply going through religious motions? True freedom comes when we surrender our spirit to His Spirit and allow Him to lead us into both truth and abundant life.
