For a new group:

For an established group:

From the Message:

1. Why do you think we tend to try and work to earn our own righteousness (Righteousness of the Law) rather than run to the righteousness of faith that comes through Jesus?
2. Why is it that only faith in Christ provides us salvation while our works do not achieve our salvation with God?
3. In Romans 10:14-15 Paul points to some basic steps necessary for people to be able to come to believe in Jesus. How do you think that happens? Who is Paul saying are sent to go and preach?
4. In the last 6 verses of Chapter 10, Paul points out that the Israelites had heard and understood the message of the gospel but chose not to heed it. Do you believe we are accountable for our decision? Why or why not?
5. Who is it that God is laying on your heart to share the gospel with/invite to church etc.?
