There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all." (Ephesians 4:1-6)

Ruminates on these verses. What is God saying through Paul? How does Paul depict walking worthily? Why does Paul emphasize unity? Then reflect on how you're walking. Are you showing humility and gentleness? Are you patient with others? Are you bearing with others in love? Are you eagerly seeking to maintain unity and peace? If you're lacking in any of these areas, repent before God and ask Him to change your heart and to bear fruit. May God bless you as you meditate on His Word and let Him transform you.

Operation Christmas Child All Year Long

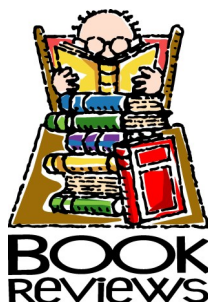


Remember you can donate items to our Operation Christmas Child project all year long! Check out the summer sales for outdoor yard toys and other goodies!

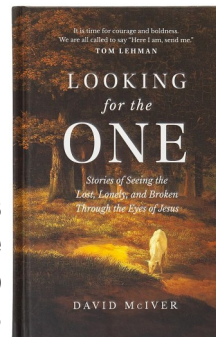


Wednesdays
