Throughout Scripture, God has revealed to us that He is able to use anyone for His purposes, no matter their past or what they've done. One such example is Paul, for he once persecuted Jesus through condemning and killing His people (Acts 9). Yet, Jesus saved Paul and enlisted him to be the apostle to the Gentiles. That is to preach the Good News of Jesus, who reigns as King over a new people purchased by His blood and that all who believe in Him can share in His inheritance. Paul writes,

"Of this gospel I was made a minister according to the gift of God's grace, which was given me by the working of his power. To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created all things, so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. So I ask you not to lose heart over what I am suffering for you, which is your glory." (Ephesians 3:7-13)

All of us who have believed in Jesus have been saved by grace and are now charged with the privilege of bringing the Good News to others: that through faith in Jesus anyone can now share in His inheritance and life. So let us do our part in sharing with boldness and confidence the gospel of Jesus.




Sunday, March 8 Daylight Savings Time Begins


Summer Jobs at Pine Haven Camp
