Put On Christ



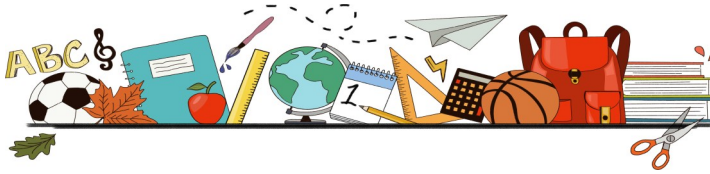
What does a transformed life in Christ look

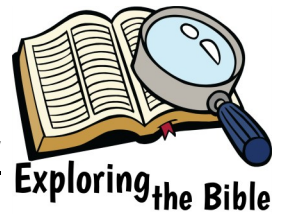
September 13 & 20 AHCC 101 Class

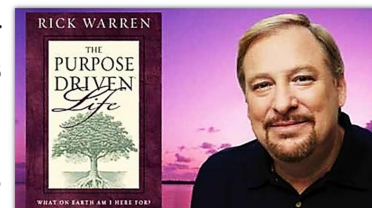

The group began its iconic mission of placing Bibles in hotel rooms in 1908 in Superior, Montana. Since then, membership has grown globally to include Protestant and evangelical Christian laymen, along with their wives who serve in an auxiliary branch. Today, the organization operates in approximately 200 countries, territories, and possessions, and has distributed over two billion Bibles and New Testaments to hotels, hospitals, schools, and prisons worldwide.
