# ZOE 333 CHALLENGE

**PVBC -  
let's be**

**DEBT FREE**

As of the end of May, 2026, our Zoe building loan balance was \$264,372. At our current payment rate, our balance at the end of 2026 will be approximately 245,000, and will take another four to five years to pay off. Our "Zoe 333 - Let's Be Debt-Free" challenge is to have 400 individuals pledge \$3.33 per day for six months (July 1 - Dec. 31, 2026), a total of 184 days. At \$3.33 per day for 184 days, the total would be \$612.72 each. Multiply this by 400 people, and it equals \$245,088. We would be paid in full at the start of 2027!

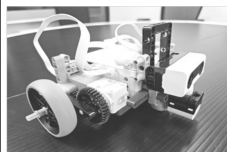

I will need parents willing to stay for the duration of our meetings. Children do not have to attend every meeting to be part of the team, There is no cost to join.

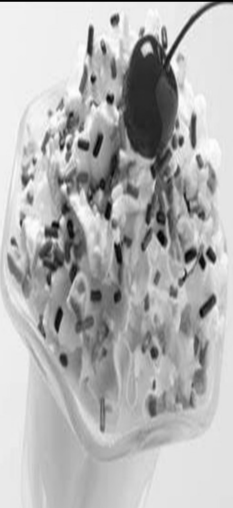
