BLESS YOUR HEART MINISTRY!

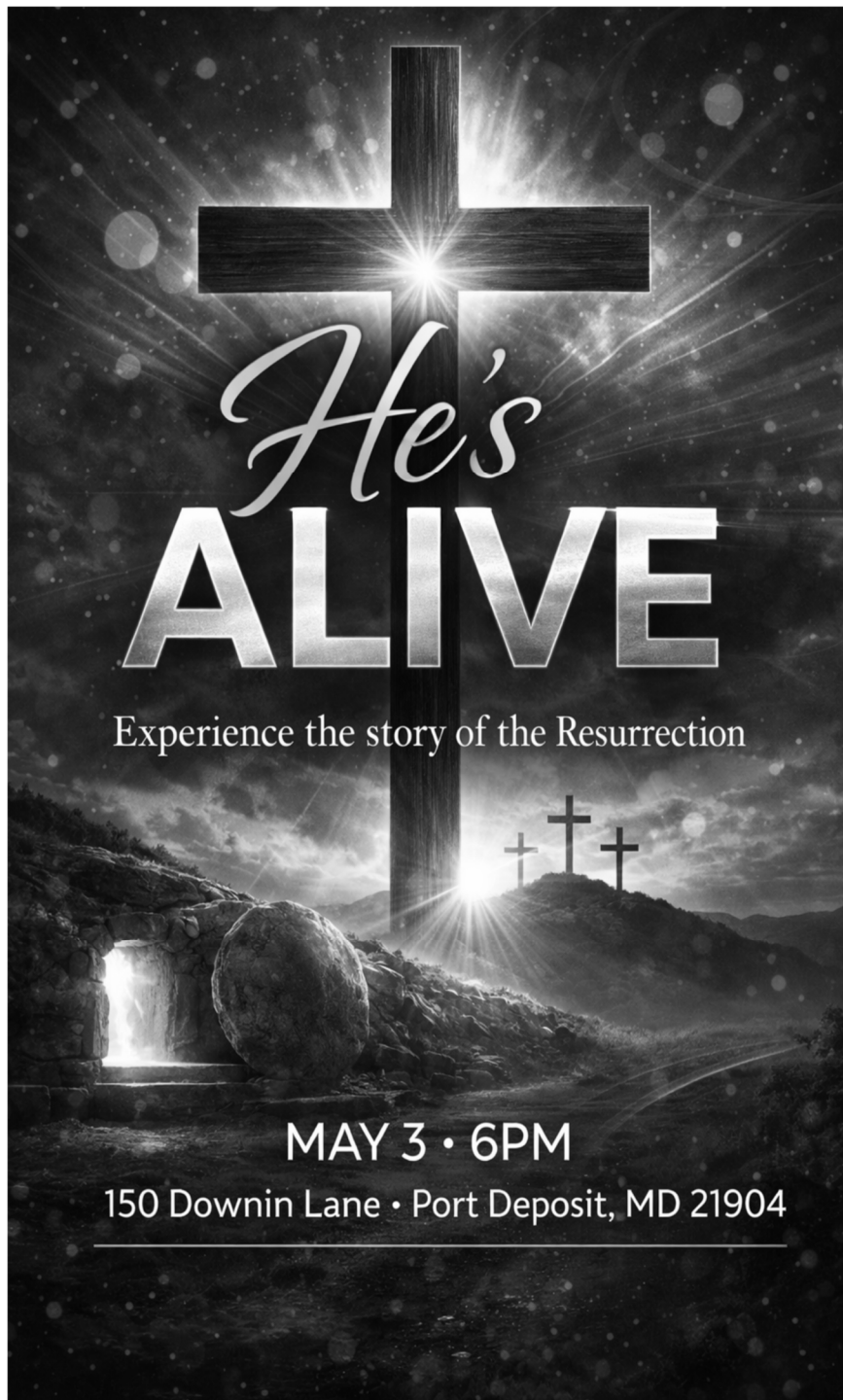

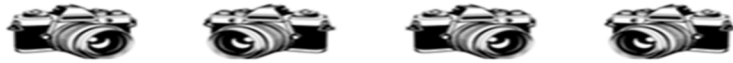

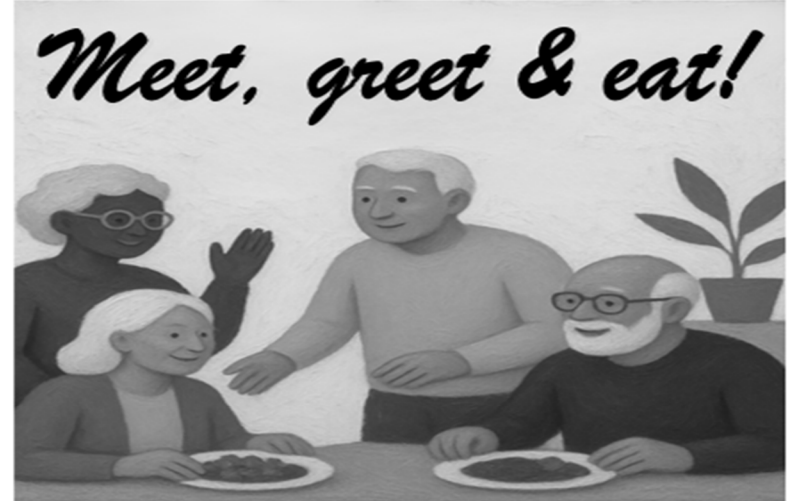
