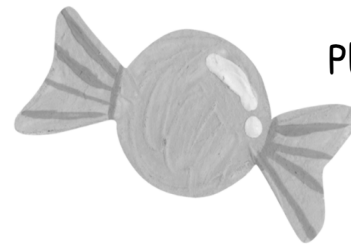

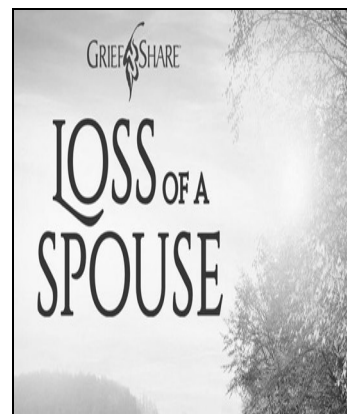

U.S. CHRISTIAN FLAG SALE

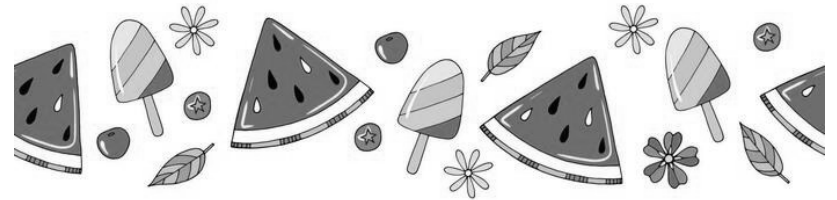
