Foster, Adoptive, Kinship Families

- We serve **all** foster, adoptive, and kinship families
- We serve the entire family, as a whole. Not just the foster youth but bio and adopted children as well.
- We serve for the **entirely** of the placement.
 - So your families can come in any time for needed items *during* the time of the placement.
- Resource Requests can be submitted and picked up by the family or the worker.
- We have pick up locations in Bay City, Midland, Gladwin and Bridgeport.
- If there are special requests or sensitivities, please include them on the resource request, we will see what we can do regarding those.
- If you are unsure about something, please ask. We are happy to answer. If the question is something we do not handle, we will do our very best to get you an answer or resource.

On-Going CPS and Reunification

- We serve families that are currently in on-going or are heading toward reunification.
- These requests **MUST** be **REQUESTED AND PICKED UP** by the worker. This provides us oversight. When the case is closed, these services stop.

Family Fellowships

- These events are for all foster, adoptive and kinship families.
- For legal guardians and minor children within the house; bio, foster, adopted.
- For confidentiality and the safety of our families. Additional adults and family members outside of the above listed are not permitted. If they come, they will be asked to leave.
- These events will be communicated via email and social media
 - **Registration is required.**

- Trainings are open to all foster, adoptive and kinship families.
