# RESPONSIVE READING

## CHRISTIAN GIVING

*Malachi 3:8-10, 1 Corinthians 16:1-3, 2 Corinthians 8:1-5; 9:6-7 (CSB)*

**Leader:** <sup>8</sup> “Will a man rob God? Yet you are robbing me! But you ask, ‘How are we robbing you?’ In tithes and offerings.

**Congregation:** <sup>9</sup> You are under a curse—your whole nation—because you are robbing me!

**Leader:** <sup>10</sup> Bring the full tithe into the storehouse so that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, “and see if I will not open the floodgates of heaven for you and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. (*Malachi 3:8-10*)

**Congregation:** <sup>1</sup> Now concerning the collection for God’s people: Just as I directed the churches of Galatia, so you should do as well.

**Congregation:** <sup>2</sup> During a severe trial, their abundant joy and their extreme poverty overflowed in rich generosity.

**Leader:** <sup>3</sup> For I testify that they gave according to their ability, and even beyond their ability, of their own accord,

**Congregation:** <sup>4</sup> begging us earnestly for the privilege of participating in this ministry to God’s people,

**Leader:** <sup>5</sup> and they gave themselves first to the Lord and then, by God’s will, to us. (*2 Corinthians 8:1-5*)

**Congregation:** <sup>6</sup> Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

**All:** <sup>7</sup> Each person should give what they have decided in their heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (*2 Corinthians 9:6-7*)
