RESPONSIVE READING

Living Sacrifice

Romans 12: 1-18 (CSB)

Leader: Therefore, brothers and sisters, in view of the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your true worship.

Congregation: Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

Leader: For by the grace given to me, I tell everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he should think. Instead, think sensibly, as God has distributed a measure of faith to each one.

Congregation: Now as we have many parts in one body, and all the parts do not have the same function, in the same way we who are many are one body in Christ and individually members of one another.

Leader: According to the grace given to us, we have different gifts: If prophecy, use it according to the proportion of one's faith; if service, use it in service; if teaching, in teaching;

Congregation: if exhorting, in exhortations; giving, with generosity; leading, with diligence; showing mercy, with cheerfulness.

Leader: Let love be without hypocrisy. Detest evil; cling to what is good. Love one another deeply as brothers and sisters. Take the lead in honoring one another.

Congregation: Do not lack diligence in zeal; be fervent in the Spirit; serve the Lord.

Leader: Rejoice in hope; be patient in affliction; be persistent in prayer. Share with the saints in their needs; pursue hospitality.

Congregation: Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep.

Leader: Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud; instead, associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own estimation.

Congregation: Do not be proud, instead, associate with the humble. Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Give careful thought to do what is honorable in everyone's eyes.

All: If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Amen.

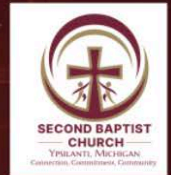

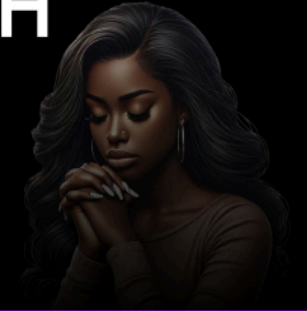
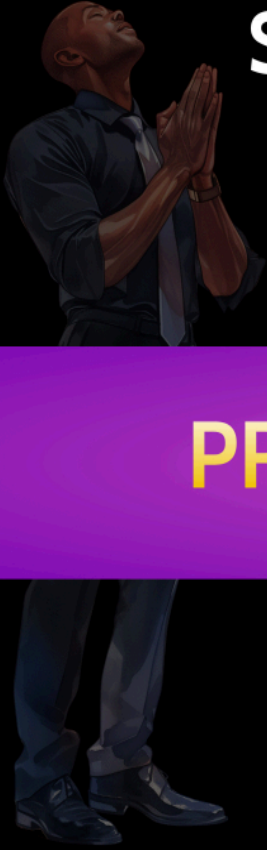
