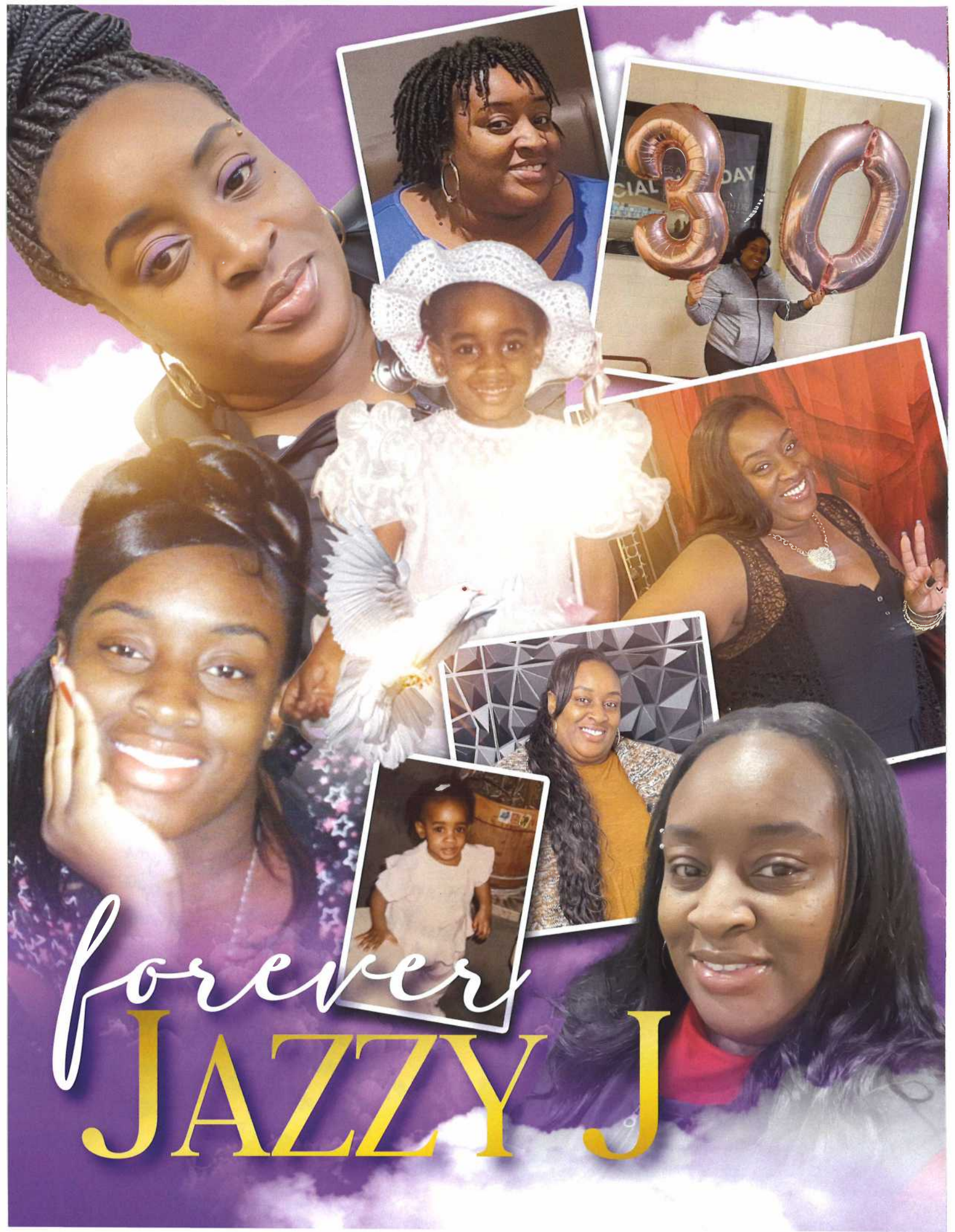

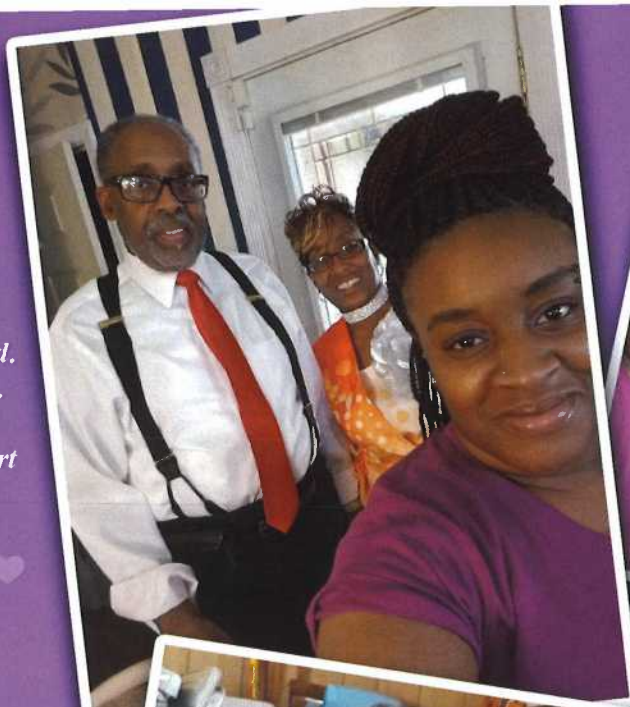
*The moment that you left me

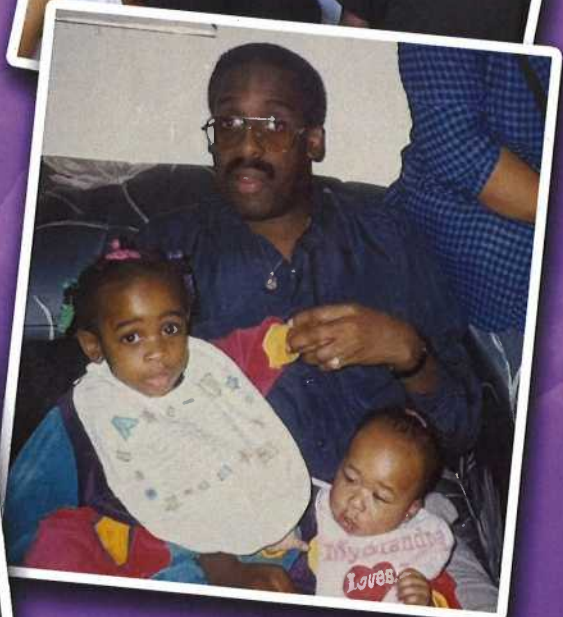
