FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- What does it mean that Jesus is powerful?
- Who is a powerful person you know? Why do you think that person is powerful?
- What are some other times in the Bible that Jesus shows how powerful He is?

Impossible Paper Trick

For this activity, you'll need a few sheets of paper and scissors. **Jesus is powerful, and He can do things that seem impossible! Jesus can raise someone from the dead and heal someone who has been sick for a long time.** Discuss: **What's something else amazing that Jesus has done?**

Take a sheet of paper and scissors and ask your kids if they can cut a hole in the paper that someone can walk through without breaking the paper. Invite them to try. Watch this [tutorial video](#) ahead of time to see how to cut the paper so that a kid (or grown adult!) can walk through the hole without breaking the paper. **Did you think it would be possible to do? Jesus can do the impossible. He is powerful!**

INTERACTIVE PRAYER

Word of Wonder Poster

Make a poster together with the Word of Wonder on it. You can take turns writing one word at a time of Job 36:26a or have one person do the writing. Use permanent marker for the writing and then invite your kids to paint it with watercolors. For a unique effect, sprinkle salt on the watercolor area before it dries.

Put the poster somewhere your family will see it. Talk together about how great and powerful Jesus is. Practice saying Job 36:26a together once a day. At bedtime, focus prayers on thanking God for His power.
