FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- What's a wrong or bad choice you have made? What happened as a result of that choice? (Be sensitive to your kids' age and maturity when sharing and listening. Encourage them with the truth that God loves them always no matter what!)
- How do you feel when you lie or do a wrong thing (sin)? What do you feel like doing after you've sinned?
- God called to Adam and Eve when they were hiding. He loved them. What do you think God wants to say to you when you do a wrong thing?



INTERACTIVE PRAYER

Noodle Prayer

During a meal or snack time, allow kids to get messy and create the infinity symbol with cooked spaghetti noodles. You could also use pipe cleaners, shoestrings, or anything else you have that's flexible.

Older kids can make these on their own, but younger kids might need some helping maneuvering the noodles. With noodles in hand, go around as a family and share prayer requests and praises. Then spend time praying together. **Remember, because God is infinite, we can trust His word that He will never give up on us. He has promised to take care of us. When we pray to Him, we can be confident that He hears and will answer!**

WALK IT ACT IT MOVE IT

Family Trust Fall

Choose the smallest person in the family to take part in a "trust fall" and fall backwards into the arms of a grown-up in the family (ideally, with the falling person crossing his arms so he doesn't try to catch himself.). Let them do it again with the falling person's eyes closed.

Afterward, talk together about trust: **The story of Adam and Eve's first sin is often called "the fall." Why do you think that is?** Allow responses. **How did it feel to be the one falling backward into someone's arms?** Allow responses. **Adam and Eve didn't trust God and His truth. Instead, they chose to disobey God, falling out of a perfect relationship with God. We all sin. We can trust God. He's like the grown-up who caught the person falling. He's always there to hold us up and help us. We can turn to God. He'll never give up on us!**
