KEY TAKEAWAY

Knowing God isn't just one sided. It starts with God, but we have a part to play too.

ACTION STEP

Ask God each morning,
"How do You want to transform me today?"

ICEBREAKERS

- What are some things you cannot do by yourself?

UNDERSTANDING THE PASSAGE. READ ROMANS 12:1-2

- What words or phrases stand out to you in these two verses? Why?
- Paul talks about both not being conformed and being transformed. What do you think is the difference between the two? What might each look like practically in someone's life?
- According to these verses, what role do we play in growing in our relationship with God? What role does God play?

SHEEP HEAR HIS VOICE. READ JOHN 10:2-5, 14-15, 27-28

- With so many voices competing for our attention, how do we become better at recognizing and following the voice of Jesus?



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THE GENTLE WHISPER. READ 1 KINGS 19:11–13

- Elijah encounters God not in the wind, earthquake, or fire, but in a gentle whisper. What makes it difficult for us to create enough quiet in our lives to listen for God? What might need to change for us to become more attentive to Him?

DIGGING DEEPER: KNOWING GOD

At the heart of our Discipleship Flightpath is KNOW. We don't simply want to know about God to know Bible stories, understand theology, or have the right answers. We want to actually know Him and have a real, growing relationship with Him. Like any relationship, it deepens as we spend time with Him, listen to His voice, and allow Him to transform us. Knowing God starts with Him, but we have a part to play as we respond to His invitation and intentionally seek Him.

- What is the difference between knowing about God and truly knowing God?
- If someone asked you, "How are you getting to know God more deeply right now?" how would you answer?
- What is one thing that may be keeping you from knowing God more deeply?
