Why should your student consider going further?

First, we want to make sure that our young adults have the continued exposure to regular Bible study. We want them to continue to grow in their faith and trust in their knowledge of Jesus Christ that will follow them into adulthood. They will be challenged to find ways to more fully incorporate their faith in their lives outside the church building and be able to defend that faith when asked.

Second, AWANA offers scholarships to certain schools for earning differing levels of awards beginning in T&T (Timothy - 4 years, Meritorious - 6 years, Citation - 10 years).

What's Trek About?

Awana Youth Ministries has launched a new 3 year middle school curriculum. This new program challenges students to wrestle with the three most important questions they're asking in middle school:

- Who am I? - *His Story* - The four big concepts of Redemption History are The Fall, Redemption and Consummation.
- Why am I here? - *His Love* - Students will not only discover why God put them here, but how He has given them unique gifts and talents to serve the world around them.
- Who's with me? - *His People* - Focuses on Biblical community, as told through the Book of Acts.

By allowing students to dive deep into the Scriptures and answer these questions for themselves we allow them to own their faith and discover what they actually believe.*

What's Journey About?

Journey establishes high school students as lifelong disciples through a deep study of God's Word, mobilizing them to live with godly perspective and evident faith. Four complete years' worth of material supports your 9th-12th grade high school ministry. Journey is a multi-year high school ministry curriculum with 4 main studies.

Disciples with Josh Griffin covers key points of the Christian life including identity in Christ, disciple of Christ, stewardship, love, suffering, church, and missions.

Advocates with Sean McDowell considers what it means to for youth to hold firm to biblical convictions and still engage in humble dialogue with the culture around us.

Witnesses with Greg Stier, Harvey Carey, and Wes Stafford provide you with what you need to train your students to live out the Great Commission, today. *
