Galatians 1:3-5 KJV Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, [4] Who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: [5] To Whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Galatians 3:7-9, 13-14, 26, 29 KJV Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. [8] And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would

justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

[9] So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

[13] Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: [14] That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

[26] For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

[29] And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 4:6-7 KJV And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. [7] Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

In all these verses God is telling us the good news that He wants us to think. I'm going to leave you with this last verse; meditate on it till you get happy, because I know it will make you happy!

Romans 8:31-33 KJV What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? [33]

Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.
