**The Word of God is Our Life!**

The Word of God is life to our spirits like oxygen is life to our body. The Bible, which is the Word of God, contains 66 books all put together. In these books God is communicating with mankind. Even though men wrote the Bible, God inspired them to do it.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 TPT Every Scripture has been written by the Holy Spirit, the breath of God. It will empower you by its instruction and correction, giving you the strength to take the right direction and lead you deeper into the path of godliness. [17] Then you will be God's servant, fully mature and perfectly prepared to fulfill any assignment God gives you.

Many people in America today are completely empty of any of God's knowledge or understanding. The devil moved on the nation of America many generations back to stop God in America. How did he do it? Well this is how, the devil knew that the Bible is God; and if he could remove the Bible from the minds of the people, he could remove God. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

John 1:1-4 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] The same was in the beginning with God. [3] All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. [4] In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.

Notice that in these verses we can see clearly that God and His Word are synonymous. So when people read the Bible, they are not just reading words; they are reading God.

When I quit running from my Father God and accepted Him, I knew that I needed to know my Father God like Jesus knew His Father. The Bible became final authority in my life, and this is how it happened. My Father God told me that if I would read and study the Bible, I could know Him. He told me that everything He is is written in the Bible. He told me that He revealed Himself to men, and they were anointed to write down who He is, thus creating the Bible. With this knowledge, I went on a journey of finding my Father God, His Son Jesus, and the Holy Ghost. Over forty years later I can tell you He has not disappointed me! My Father God is amazing, and I have just barely started experiencing the fullness of a relationship with Him. In the rest of this Newsletter I will show you Scriptures about our amazing Father, His Son, and Holy Spirit.

John 3:34-35 KJV For He Whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure

unto Him. [35] The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into His hand.

John 5:24 KJV Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John 6:47-69 KJV Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me hath everlasting life. [48] I Am that bread of life. [49] Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. [50] This is the bread which cometh down from Heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. [51] I Am the living bread which came down from Heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is My flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. [52] The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us His flesh to eat? [53] Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink His blood, ye have no life in you. [54] Whoso eateth My flesh, and drinketh My blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. [55] For My flesh is meat indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. [56] He that eateth My flesh, and drinketh My blood, dwelleth in Me, and I in him. [57] As the living Father hath sent Me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth Me, even he shall live by Me. [58] This is that bread which came down from Heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are

dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever. [59] These things said He in the synagogue, as He taught in Capernaum. [60] Many therefore of His disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it? [61] When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples murmured at it, He said unto them, Doth this offend you? [62] What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where He was before? [63] It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. [64] But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray Him. [65] And He said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto Me, except it were given unto him of My Father. [66] From that time many of His disciples went back, and walked no more with Him. [67] Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? [68] Then Simon Peter answered Him, Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life. [69] And we believe and are sure that Thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.
