**Faith in God Brings Victory**

Victory in anyone's life only comes by their Faith in God and His Word. In today's Newsletter, I'm going to be sharing with you how we, as born-again Christians, can live the victorious life that God has already planned for us to live. The devil is a liar and the father of lies. He really has only one weapon with which he can stop the Christian - that is unbelief. When a born-again Christian learns how to function and operate in the God-kind of Faith, that Christian will destroy the works of the devil. In this Newsletter, we will be showing you how to function in this God-kind of Faith; so let's get into Scripture verses that show us what Faith is, what Faith can do, and what Faith has done.

To begin with, we're going to define what the God-kind of Faith is; so let's look at Hebrews the 11th chapter.

Hebrews 11:1-3 KJV Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. [2] For by it the elders obtained a good report. [3] Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

## Hebrews 11:1-3 AMPC

Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]. [2] For by [faith-trust and holy fervor born of faith] the men of old had divine testimony borne to them and obtained a good report. [3] By faith we understand that the worlds [during the successive ages] were framed (fashioned, put in order, and equipped for their intended purpose) by the word of God, so that what we see was not made out of things which are visible.

If a Christian would spend about a week of taking apart these three verses in both the King James and the Amplified Classic versions, they would be ahead of most seminary graduates. I believe that most Christians don't have a clue of what Faith is, so let's look at some words in these verses. Notice that Faith is now; HOPE is future. Faith is always NOW in the spiritual world. Everything that will happen by us believing is already there; it just hasn't manifested in the physical world yet. The spiritual world is the world God lives in, and God is a spirit and does not live in time. Everything is NOW in the spiritual world, because God is the great I AM; not the great I will be. So when I see something in the Bible that God says is future, to God it is now before it ever manifests. God has given birth to me and you, and because God is a spirit, WE are spirit beings. Our natural head and

thinking perceive us as just physical, but the Bible shows us that we are spiritual. We are spirits! So as a born-again Christian, we can live mentally where we already are spiritually, if we take the Bible literally.

Hebrews 11:1 AMPC Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

In this verse we see Faith perceives as real fact, what is not revealed to the senses. So Bible Faith receives from God's Word, the Bible, what God says as real without asking our 5 senses if it is real. We take what God's says over what our natural circumstances say. If God said it, I receive it as real fact. I don't debate with my 5 senses whether it is true or not. In the spiritual world it's already there, even if it hasn't come into this natural world. Our job, as Christians, is to find in the Bible what God says about us, believe it, and declare it with our mouth; and watch God bring it to pass in our lives. I will leave with this favorite verse of mine.

Mark 11:22-23 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his

heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Have faith in God.
