John 4:31-34 NCV Meanwhile, His followers were begging Him, "Teacher, eat something." [32] But Jesus answered, "I have food to eat that you know nothing about." [33] So the followers asked themselves, "Did somebody already bring Him food?" [34] Jesus said, "My food is to do what the One who sent Me wants me to do and to finish His work.

God made the whole world by speaking Words, as you can see in Genesis the first chapter. Right now, if we live in His Word, we are living in God. God takes care

Colossians 1:13-23 KJV Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son: [14] In Whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins: [15] Who is the image of the invisible God, the Firstborn of every creature: [16] For by Him were all things created, that are in Heaven, and that are in Earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him: [17] And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. [18] And He is the Head of the Body, the Church: Who is the beginning, the Firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence. [19] For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell; [20] And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in Earth, or things in Heaven. [21] And

you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath He reconciled [22] In the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in His sight: [23] If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the Gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under Heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

John 1:1-5, 13-14 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] The same was in the beginning with God. [3] All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. [4] In Him was life; and the life was the light of men. [5] And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. [13] Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. [14] And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only Begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
