The Bible: A Book Written by Witnesses

The Bible is a Book written by witnesses testifying for God so that we can have faith to receive what God has spoken. These witnesses wrote the Bible as actual testimonial statements. In a court of law, if we were the jury, we would hear witnesses that would cause us to believe based on their testimonies. The Bible is a book of testimonies from God's chosen people so that we can believe.

If the Apostle Paul, or any other author in the Bible, were to be called to be a witness in a court of law, they would take the stand and say what God had told them to write in the Bible. We must not look at the Bible as words spoken from just anybody; we should see these words coming from witnesses ordained by God to speak to us so that we can believe God and receive what He has promised us in the Bible.

I have just a few verses from those witnesses to produce faith in our hearts to receive from God. Let us read them and praise the Lord.

Acts 1:8, 21-26 KJV But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses

unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth..

[21] Wherefore of these men which have companied with us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, [22] Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that He was taken up from us, must one be ordained to be a witness with us of His resurrection. [23] And they appointed two, Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias. [24] And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two Thou hast chosen, [25] That he may take part of this ministry and apostleship, from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place. [26] And they gave forth their lots; and the lot fell upon Matthias; and he was numbered with the eleven apostles.

Acts 3:14-15 KJV But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; [15] And killed the Prince of life, Whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

Acts 4:33 KJV And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Acts 5:31-32 KJV Him hath God exalted with His right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. [32] And we are His

witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, Whom God hath given to them that obey Him.

Acts 10:38-46 KJV How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him. [39] And we are witnesses of all things which He did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; Whom they slew and hanged on a tree: [40] Him God raised up the third day, and shewed Him openly; [41] Not to all the people, but unto witnesses chosen before of God, even to us, who did eat and drink with Him after He rose from the dead. [42] And He commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is He which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. [43] To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whosoever believeth in Him shall receive remission of sins. [44] While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. [45] And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. [46] For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God.

Acts 22:12-15 KJV And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt there, [13] Came unto me, and stood, and said unto me, Brother Saul, receive thy sight. And the same hour

I looked up upon him. [14] And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest know His will, and see that Just One, and shouldest hear the voice of His mouth. [15] For thou shalt be His witness unto all men of what thou hast seen and heard.

1 John 5:9 KJV If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which He hath testified of His Son.

Hebrews 10:15 KJV Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us...

Romans 8:15-16 KJV For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Romans 10:13-15 KJV For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. [14] How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? [15] And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

I'm closing this Newsletter now, but I would like for you to listen to all of my teachings that I've taught on this subject. You will take a leap of faith by understanding this revelation!!
