**Do You Know Who You Are in Christ?**

Knowing yourself as God knows you is the most securing and stabilizing effect in a Christian's life. Until you see yourself in Christ, you will have major insecurity, which will cause you to not be productive for God or humanity. Jesus would always tell people who His Father said He was. He was very confident. He didn't doubt Himself, because He knew Himself based on His Father's words.

The Christian world today has been taught to think of themselves the way they were before they received Christ. In fact, most of your main-line Christian seminaries and ministries are based on doctrines that go against the Apostle Paul's writings. The Apostle Paul always talked about who you are in Christ. He didn't say that you were like the world. He didn't call you a 'sinner saved by grace'! That is a lie that came from traditional doctrines of churches that have no standing with God Himself. In today's Newsletter, we will be showing you Scripture verse after Scripture verse of what God says you are as a born-again Christian. We must take ownership of what God has made us in Christ Jesus. So let's find out, through Scriptures, who we are and live out the glorious new person that we are in Christ.

Romans 8:1-2 KJV There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. [2] For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Ephesians 2:10 KJV For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

John 14:18-20; 15-5 KJV I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. [19] Yet a little while, and the world seeth Me no more; but ye see Me: because I live, ye shall live also. [20] At that day ye shall know that I am in My Father, and ye in Me, and I in you.

15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in Me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.

Paul said that God called him to make known to us the mystery. This mystery is still being revealed to us from his writings; let's look at it.

Colossians 1:25-27 KJV Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God; [26] Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints: [27] To whom God

would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

Because we are in Christ, and Christ is in us, there is no power on this earth that is greater than the believer with this revelation. So we must meditate on our spiritual identity; not just our natural identity.

Romans 8:15-17 KJV For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: [17] And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.
