Do You See Yourself Like God Sees You?

When we were born again, we became completely-new spiritual creations inside our natural bodies. If we will finally start seeing ourselves the way God sees us in His Bible, we will start living the new life He has given us. Let's look at the Scriptures that reveal to us what God sees about us.

Ephesians 1:17-18 KJV That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him: [18] The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

Ephesians 3:15-19 KJV Of Whom the whole family in Heaven and Earth is named, [16] That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man; [17] That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, [18] May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; [19] And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

2 Corinthians 5:16-17 NLT So we have stopped evaluating others from a human point of view. At one time we thought of Christ merely from a human point of view. How differently we know Him now! [17] This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

It's all about recognizing that we have become what God is; we are God's children, and now we just have to grow up and be conscious of our new being in Christ. This will take time studying God's Word that tells us our new identity in Christ. We were born human beings, and as we learned about human life, we started living that life. Now, in the same way, we have learned that we are born again spiritually, so we learn about our new spiritual life: now all that Jesus shows us, we can do as well!

We start out as spiritual babies with God's DNA, which made us to be what we will do. Living the Christian life becomes easy to live, when we identify with the new being that we are in Him.
