**Don't Worry Anymore; God's Got You!**

Many of God's chosen people, in the church, worry all the time about their lives. They are so concerned that something bad will happen to them. Now, there is a lot in this world that is bad, and this is a very dangerous world to live in; so people without God should worry! But we Christians are NOT without GOD! As born-again Christians, our spiritual Father is the Creator of everything; and if we will trust Him with our lives, He will protect us and provide for us. The key is knowing that He will do what He said He will do. In this Newsletter we will be encouraging you to trust in God and not lean on your own human frailty. Human beings can learn how to become really good at helping and taking care of themselves, but there are times that what you can do for yourself is not going to be enough. As we get into Scriptures from the Bible today, we must take ownership of what God is telling us; and let Him have our lives so that He can take care of us. We must learn to depend on Him more.

Proverbs 3:5-6 KJV Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. [6] In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.

Jeremiah 1:4-10 KJV Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, [5] Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. [6] Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, I cannot speak: for I am a child. [7] But the LORD said unto me, Say not, I am a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak. [8] Be not afraid of their faces: for I am with thee to deliver thee, saith the LORD. [9] Then the LORD put forth His hand, and touched my mouth. And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have put My words in thy mouth. [10] See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

Psalms 91:1-10 KJV He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. [2] I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust. [3] Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. [4] He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler. [5] Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; [6] Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. [7] A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come

nigh thee. [8] Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. [9] Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; [10] There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

In these Scriptures we see our Father God wants us to trust Him to protect us and provide for us. If we would take Scriptures like these and meditate on them; thinking about them day in and day out, we would start knowing that we know longer have to worry and be overly concerned about our lives. Our Father God knew us as babies, and even before we were born; we wouldn't even be here without Him making it happen. So I will leave you with this thought that will wake you up to recognize the truth and not believe the devil's lies anymore: ---Do we really think that we can do a better job of taking care of our lives than God?---  
It's time right now to stop trying: Let go, and Let God.
