My Inward Man Can See the Spirit World!

Today I want to talk about being able to see spiritually so that we now can function and operate as spiritual beings; not just physical beings. If everyone in the world were blind naturally, there would be no air travel; there would be no car travel; we would be limited in such a terrible way that we could never experience the goodness of this natural earth. But because God created us with natural eyes, we now can develop and function in this world, that is material, and be successful doing what God wants us to do naturally. But there's also a spiritual world that we enter into when we're born again. God wants us to operate and function in that spiritual dimension just like we operate and function in the natural dimension. In the natural, we operate and function through our five senses. In the spiritual realm, we operate and function by faith. Faith is our senses to the spirit, and faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

I'm going to give you some Scripture verses today that talk about us living in a spiritual world while we're still living in our physical bodies. You might think, "Well, Pastor Paul, it seems like this is all you teach on anymore". That's correct!! We are so behind in living a spiritual life, because our spirit

hasn't been given the attention that our physical body has. So let's get into the Scripture verses that bear this out.

John 3:3-8 KJV Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God. [4] Nicodemus saith unto Him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? [5] Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God. [6] That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. [8] The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

2 Corinthians 4:16 KJV For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

Romans 8:6,14-16 KJV [6] For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace... [14] For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. [15] For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself

(Himself) beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Our Father God has given birth to us in the spirit so that we can now live like Jesus on the earth, but it's only going to be through our reborn spirit; not through just our body and flesh. Yes, we have to renew our mind, but what is it you renew your mind to think? The Lord told me a long time ago that the renewing of the mind has to be by receiving revelation of the new person I am in the spirit. Now, because I'm born again, I am a spirit; and I can function in a spiritual world just like I function in this natural world. Our five senses give us the ability to operate physically; our faith gives us the ability to operate spiritually. So now the mind has to connect with the spirit just like the mind is connected to the body. We are going to get this done! Hallelujah! Praise the Lord!
