Updates from the March 21, 2023 Council Meeting

- Treasurer's Report
 - While giving is on the increase, there is still a large dependence on the endowments.
 - o The year end Endowment Report was given.
- Ministry Report
 - Digital Ministry-The new website will be going live very soon. All Lenten and Easter services will be livestreamed.
- Approval of Jason Sheppard to serve a three year term on the Audit Committee.
- Both the Procedure Committee and the Safe and Secure: A Ministry Approach Committee are currently Ad Hoc Committee and will work in conjunction with the Property Committee.
- Postcards will be mailed out to the congregation to "Come and See" the next chapter in the life of Trinity with the arrival of the Pastors Felici.
- LaBlast exercise class will be asked to complete a Facility Request form and provide proof of insurance to the Council.
- A motion to accept a grant check for Sisters in Christ (\$1500) from the Synod by Trinity was passed. It was recommended that the Finance Committee determine how to process the check.
- A motion from the Finance Committee to renew our \$20,000 Mission Bond for 3 years at the fixed rate of 3.46% was passed.
- A motion from the Special Gifts Committee to approve \$500 from the Yost Family Memorial Fund for a monetary gift to Pastor Clement from the congregation.
