REFRESHER CLASS



Art At Trinity

In the small side narthex by the planter are several items of interest, old and more recent. On your right as you enter from the outside glass door is a photograph of the chancel by Jonathan Nakles Photography.

On the wall by the sacristy is a bronze plaque with a door. Open the door and your will find "Trinity Beautiful Memorial Furniture" contributors from 1965.

On the wall by the planter is a photograph of Bishop Donald McCoid when he was installed as Bishop of S.W. PA Synod in 1987.

The bronze statue of "Christ Washing the Feet of Peter" was sculpted by Jan Barone, a local artist. The congregation voted this art piece #1 in July 2003. She then gave us another sculpture entitled "Mother and Child" which is now on display in the lounge. Please take some time to enjoy and study Trinity's art.
