Circle the picture that is different.

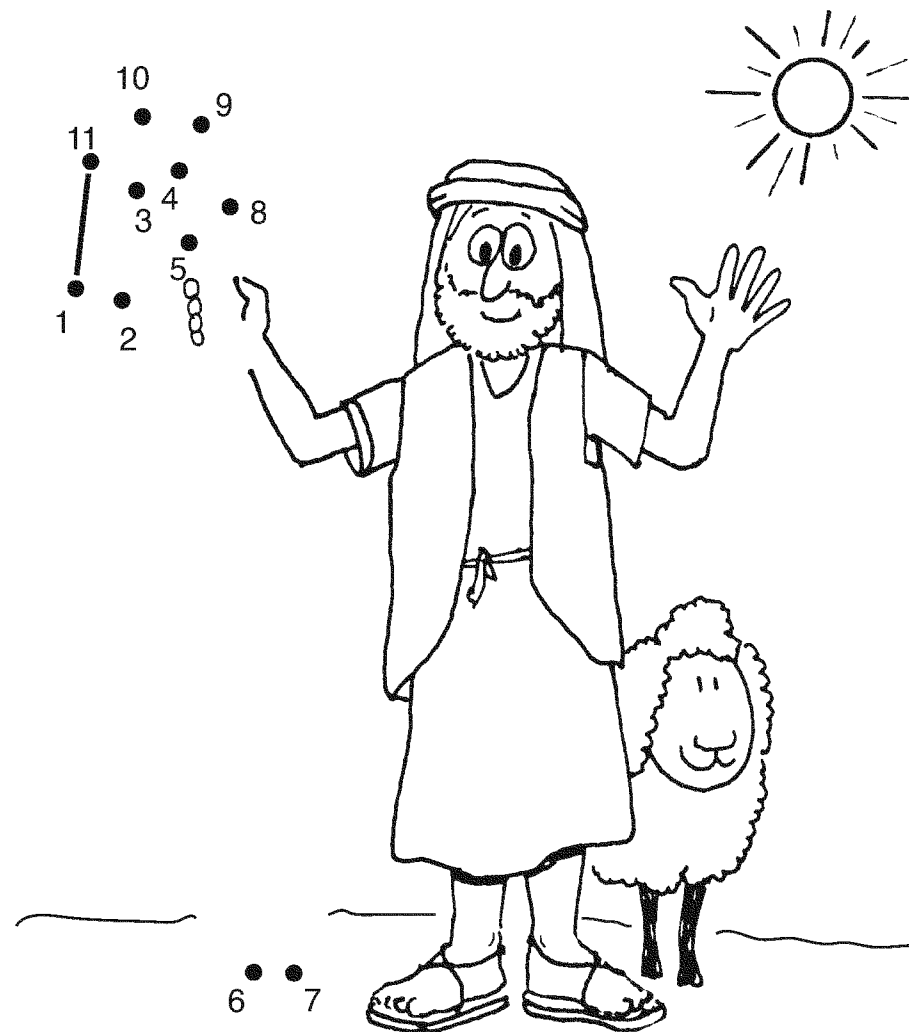


“See that you don’t despise one of these little ones.”
