Upgrades and Updates

Just like in your own home where you have to repair things and make periodic upgrades, from time to time we need to do the same thing with our church building. Over the next two months you're going to see a few improvements being made to our building at Holy Cross. We're going to repair a few things, upgrade a few things, and replace a few things.

The first of these is a series of repairs and upgrades to the glass doors you use to enter the building. The goal is to make our church building more secure when and where it needs to be. The locking mechanisms will be upgraded to better and safer functionality. We're also adding a security film to entryway glass that is optically clear and designed to strengthen glass, hold shattered fragments together, and delay forced entry. The goal is to make sensible security upgrades that hopefully are also fairly unobtrusive.

The second of these improvements is upgrades to the sanctuary lighting. Currently the lighting system that illuminates the chancel area (the area surrounding the altar, pulpit, and baptismal font) is an underpowered track lighting system. If you've ever thought things looked dim when you were in worship, it's because the track lights simply don't put out enough umens. It's especially bad around the altar and just behind it. If you're thinking "what are you talking about? The light is fine", you've probably just gotten used to how things are. Additionally, we recently had one of the light fixtures from the track fall out. Thankfully it wasn't during Sunday morning church! In response, we're replacing the inadequate track lights with a proper modern lighting system. The result will be improved visibility, a more joyful and positive feeling of the space, and greatly improved camera performance for the livestreaming of church to people at home. These upgrades don't change anything about the hanging fixtures over the seating area.

Most of the work will happen during the week sometime this summer and shouldn't affect anything on Sunday morning. However, there will be a Sunday when you come to church and think "hey, that door is slightly different" or "Wow, it's brighter and I can see easier here in the sanctuary." When that happens, you'll know why.

In the meantime, Holy Cross Family let's keep being people of God who share our lives together in worship, love, and friendship. Let's keep being people of God who regularly read His Word (Read the New Testament!). Let's keep being people of prayer for our families, each other, and the world.
