OUTLINE

REVIEW

READ Revelation 19

OBSERVE

1. What are the 2 feasts of Revelation 19? (9 & 17)
2. Why is God praised when Jesus returns? (1-3 & 6-8)
3. How did the Bride make herself ready? (7-8)

INTERPRET

1. Think back through Revelation. What temptations were noted that led to people denying Jesus as King?
2. Considering the temptations to deny Jesus as King, why is he still worthy of worship?

ASSESS

1. When you think of Jesus returning to earth, what thoughts and emotions does that idea prompt? What leads to those thoughts and emotions?
2. Verse 8 says the church “was granted” to clothe herself with “righteous deeds”. How have you experienced God changing your desires and abilities to do righteous deeds?
3. If it is God who grants us the ability to do righteous deeds, how can we encourage one another in righteous deeds?
4. People who resist Jesus will face justice when he returns. How does this fact impact the way you interact with other people? How should it?
