2. What is the significance of the repeated 12's in Revelation's description of New Jerusalem? (10-21)
3. What does this text say people will be doing in eternity? (21:3-4, 24-27 & 22:5)

INTERPRET

1. What are some reasons people don't live for eternity?
2. What is compelling about the Bible's promises for eternity?

ASSESS

1. Throughout your week, when are you most focused on the hope of eternity, and when does that hope fade to the background?
2. What would a life that is shaped by the hope of eternity look like? How would this life look different from the way everyone else lives?
3. In what ways does your life look like a life that is shaped by the hope of eternity? In what ways does it not?
4. The joy of eternity will be dwelling in God's presence and working for his kingdom with his power. How are you enjoying God's presence and working for his kingdom today?
5. How do you respond when you suffer evil?
