## ASSESS

1. How does the fact that everyone needs redemption affect the way you view yourself? How should it affect the way you view other people?
2. What is your typical response to temptation?
3. What should your response to temptation look like if you deeply believe you have been redeemed from the power and authority of sin?
4. Jesus paid an immense price to redeem you. What does that tell you about the worth and value Jesus places on you?
5. How well does your service and worship reflect your belief in your redemption?
