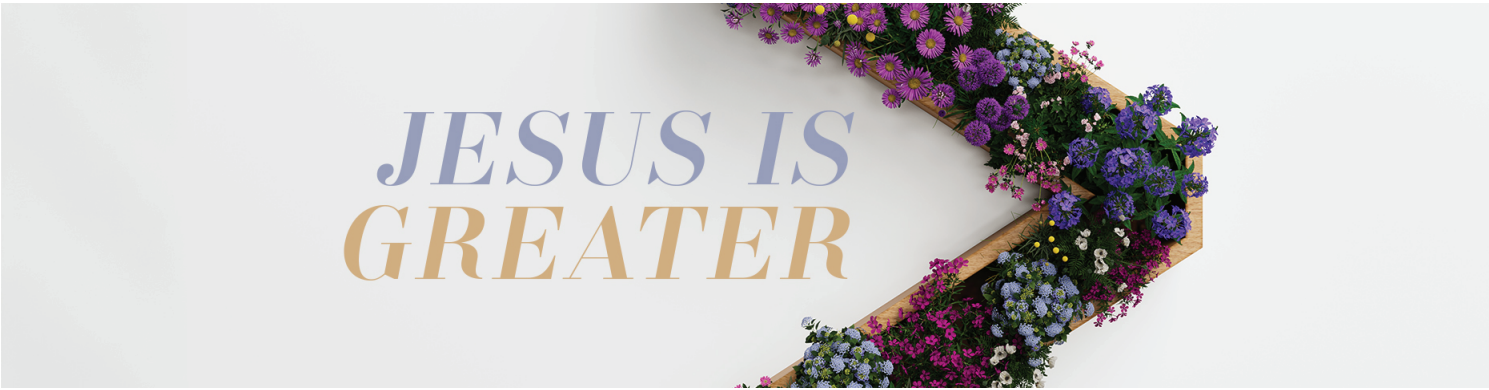




JESUS IS GREATER

INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are some areas in your life where time seems to be catching up with you?
2. Read Hebrews 13:8. Why is it important that Jesus is the same "yesterday"?
3. How do Old Testament appearances of Jesus (e.g., Hagar, Joshua, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego) show his timeless involvement in human lives?
4. Which of Jesus' actions during his earthly ministry (healing, calming storms, forgiving, etc.) resonates with you the most? Why?
5. Read Matthew 13:58 and Mark 6:5-6. How does unbelief limit what Jesus does in our lives today?
6. In what ways might we be underestimating what Jesus can do in our families, churches, or personal lives?
7. What are some "tiles of unbelief" in your life that you may need to remove?
8. How does knowing that Jesus is the same forever bring comfort or challenge to you? Read Acts 1:11. How should the promise of Jesus' return impact how we live today?
9. What was your biggest takeaway from the message, and why?
